




Starting on 15 March 2020, France's Public Finances Directorate General (DGFiP) will no longer cash cheques drawn on foreign banks.

We will be happy to advise you about other ways — including bank transfers and bank cards — that you can use to pay your taxes, public services and fines, and to purchase tax stamps.

Other means of payment include:









* A cheque is said to be foreign when it is either issued in euros and drawn on a foreign bank or issued in foreign currency and drawn on a foreign bank.
